The BLRC's 1st, 2nd and 3rd division teams offer a full range of playing experiences.

Senior Women's Our senior women's team competes in the BC Rugby Union's Premier Women's Division and is looking to expand with a 2nd Division team next year. The BLRC Premier women's team proved to be the best in the province as they were crowned BC Rugby Union's 2003 Champions!

Junior Men's and Women's For boys and girls aged 14 to 19. Players at this level experience the camaraderie and friendship of team sport as well as the opportunity for world travel on one of the club organized tours.

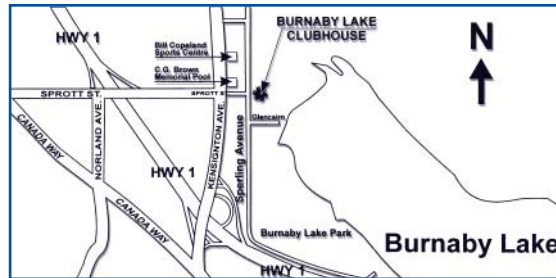
