



Burnaby Lake Rugby Club Senior Scholarship Program

1 Purpose

Burnaby Lake Rugby Club seeks to recruit and retain individuals that contribute to the success of the club, both on and off the field. To this end, BLRC is proud to offer a scholarship program for club members entering or continuing a full-time post-secondary education program.

2 Eligibility

To be eligible for a senior scholarship, an applicant must:

1. be attending or entering a full-time post-secondary education program within the Greater Vancouver area for the duration of the season for which the scholarship is tenable;
2. be a senior member in good standing of the Burnaby Lake Rugby Club;
3. be a rugby player of estimable promise; and
4. be a volunteer in one or more of the following BLRC activities:
 - high school rugby coaching
 - mini rugby coaching
 - youth rugby refereeing

3 Considerations

Consideration will be given to each candidate's:

- duration and intensity of service to the club,
- commitment to development as a rugby player, and
- promise of future contributions to the club.

4 Application Requirements

Applicants are required to submit a letter outlining their involvement in the rugby club and proof of enrollment in a full-time post-secondary education program in the Greater Vancouver area. If an applicant has not yet registered, he or she should submit proof of application or acceptance at a post-secondary education institution.

5 Submission and Deadline

Applications must be submitted to Joe Lee before midnight February 28, 2010.

6 Notice of Recipients

Scholarship recipients shall be determined by the BLRC Scholarship Committee and a list of recipients posted on the club notice board. Scholarship funds will only be disbursed to recipients who provide proof of enrollment.
